Long Term Nurse Leader Role

CRUDEM Foundation, a 501C3 non-profit US-based organization, is seeking a mature, experienced individual willing to make a difference in many lives by accepting a one (1) year permanent placement at CRUDEM compound in Milot, Haiti.

The person selected in this leadership role should have previous mission experience. Ideally, the candidate will also have many years of nursing/medical experience and have good leadership/management skills. (No new college graduates please; Married couples welcome to apply.) While at CRUDEM, he/she will work closely with the Haitian staff, particularly the Medical Director, the Nursing Supervisor and the Coordinator for Training for all staffing assignments and with the various physician-led visiting teams. Creating and maintaining a cohesive "CRUDEM Team" each week will be the goal for the leader, while having all oversight of the needs of the hospital to match-up the CRUDEM volunteers. A flexible, humble, can-do attitude is essential.

Strong communication skills are also a requirement and will be a key responsibility of the position. At minimum, it would be important to give a weekly account of activity at CRUDEM headquarters. The leader must ensure that all volunteers adhere to CRUDEM policies, and if not, they will be requested to leave. The leader will consult CRUDEM office in the states with any problematic or questionable issues that arise. All blogging and other communications are subject to CRUDEM approval.

Specifics to this role include:

*Be the "face" of CRUDEM. Welcome all visitors and volunteers to CRUDEM. Learn CRUDEM's history well to conduct tours and provide accurate information to all arriving visitors and volunteers.

* Manage CRUDEM daily staffing assignments after receiving and reviewing the weekly Master Schedule from the CRUDEM office. Coordinate with MD leaders of visiting teams and HSC Medical Director, Nursing Administration and Training Coordinator. Be the CRUDEM liaison to HSC.

* Conduct daily nursing staff meetings and conduct CRUDEM all-volunteer Welcome and nightly Meetings.

* Promote and demand adherence to CRUDEM Policies, keeping them prominently displayed at CRUDEM for reference.

* Help maintain the Catholic identity and values of the CRUDEM mission.

Stipend: \$ 6,000 annually (\$ 500 per month); all room and board covered—3 meals provided daily. One day off per week; one 2-3 day weekend off per month; one week vacation every 6 months to travel back to US. Travel outside Milot allowed at discretion of Medical Director and/or CFO who both live on CRUDEM grounds. Also, Creole tutoring offered free of charge.

Also Covered: Travel expenses to and from Haiti, and medical and emergency evacuation insurance.

Candidate should be mature, exhibit good judgment, good communicator, have strong leadership skills, technologically competent and personally share the Catholic/Christian values and mission of the organization.

Please submit a short written essay why you want the position, any relevant prior experience with an updated resume. CRUDEM's President and Hôpital Sacré Coeur's Medical Director will conduct the interviewing process, with any additional board members they wish to include.

The candidate will be required to complete a "trial week with supervision" prior to acceptance to this position. This visit to CRUDEM in Milot will be for approximately one week with a board member. If accepted, roundtrip airfare will be covered for position.
